ITEMS TO BRING TO YOUR PET'S PHOTO SHOOT

- Waste bags
- Favorite treats
- Squeaky toys to get your dog's attention during the shoot and favorite toy
- Props ... holiday or your favorite for your dog. Not necessary, up to you!
- Water (for you and your dog)
- Best leash, collar, harness
- Pet grooming wipes for touchups

Groom and Bathe/Nail Trim: With active dogs you may need to wait until the day before to bathe ensuring your dog is as clean and shiny as possible. If you have a breed of dog that is "scruffy" around the face, I highly recommend a trim of the hairs around the eyes.

Make sure they get lots of sleep: Dogs can be in good or bad moods, just like humans. Make sure your dog gets a full nights rest so they are ready for their photo shoot and being the star!

Get Ready: After you make your final preparations all that is left is to rest up, relax and get excited for the fun experience headed your way!
